



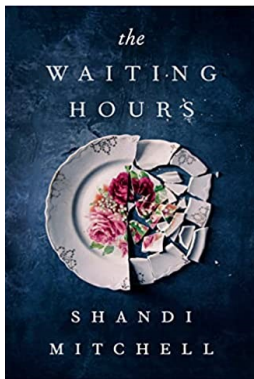

Join the Discussion! Zoom Evening Book Club

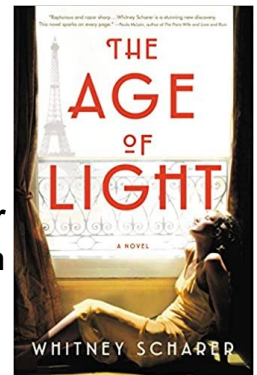
The SMPL Book Club meets on the 4th Thursday of each month via Zoom

Live Stream Tea & Books

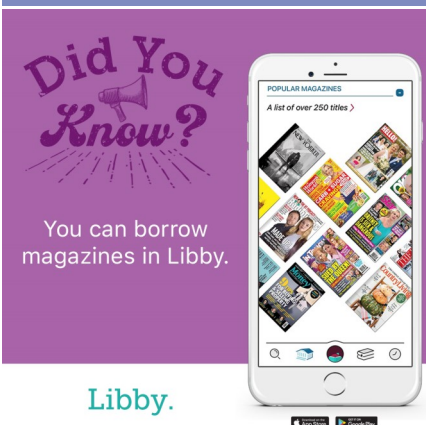
