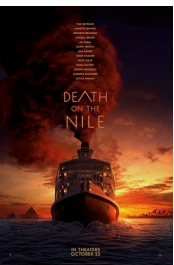

Registration is required for all programs.

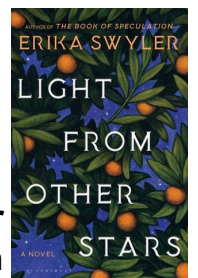
