The Kent Farndale Bursary for the Arts is funded by the annual support of the Rotary Club of Port Perry and by donations from local organizations and members of the public. The Bursary provides financial assistance in the amount of \$1000 to residents of Scugog Township who wish to pursue a specific field of study in the arts.

It is felt that the whole community is enriched when aspiring or established artists take time out for further study in their areas of interest. Applicants may wish to take a workshop, attend a specialized learning facility, or take a college or university course. Areas of study may involve creative writing, music, dance, drama, painting, sculpting, weaving, or any other field of art.

Scugog residents of all ages are eligible to receive the Kent Farndale Bursary for the Arts, which is awarded annually. The deadline for applications is **Wednesday, May 24th, 2023 at 5pm.** Applications may be dropped off at the library or emailed to Amy Caughlin at **acaughlin@scugoglibrary.ca**.

The application is deemed complete if it includes the following:

- o Basic Information page
- o Written responses to Statements 1-4
- o One Letter of Reference
- o Examples of work, which could include photographs, digital files, or photocopies (no original work).

Please note that incomplete applications will not be considered, and that decisions made by the Kent Farndale Bursary for the Arts Committee will be final.
