- 305 children signed up and attended 71 programs in our TD Summer Reading Club
- 141 people learned a language and others completed 19,124 family history searches using our online resources.
- Our successful weekly movie night program was enjoyed by 1,683 people!

- Our circulating Wi Fi hotspots went out 199 times and our new Chromebooks 45 times.
