Thursday, September 7th at 6:30 pm (1 hr 38 min) Rated PG* (Alberta & BC) In the West End of 1950s London, plans for a movie version of a smash-hit play come to an abrupt halt after a pivotal member of the crew is murdered. When world-weary Inspector Stoppard (Sam Rockwell) and eager rookie Constable Stalker (Saoirse Ronan) take on the case, the two find themselves thrown into a puzzling whodunit within the glamorously sordid theater underground, investigating the mysterious homicide at their own peril.

Bones of Crows

Thursday, September 28th at 6:30 pm (2 hr 9 min) Rated 14A* (Alberta & BC) Unfolding over 100 years, Bones of Crows is told through the eyes of Cree Matriarch Aline Spears as she survives a childhood in Canada's residential school system to continue her family's generational fight in the face of systemic starvation, racism, and abuse.




Mark your calendars for the first PA Day of the 2023-2024 school year!
