Brick Masters Building Contest 2024: Rules

- Each participant is permitted to enter up to two (2) brick block creations.
- Participants may use any type of connecting brick block to make their creation, such as LEGO, DUPLO, Mega Blocks, etc. Creations may also include hinges, movable parts, and Minifigures.
- The five age categories this year are:
 - 1) Little Builders (ages 3-6)
 - 2) Builders (ages 7-12)
 - 3) Master Builders (ages 13-adult)
 - 4) Duo (group of two, any age. e.g. siblings, friends, parent/child)
 - 5) Construction Team (for groups of family members or friends of any age)
- Each creation should be original. Please do not enter a sculpture that follows the instructions of a LEGO kit, Internet instructions, etc. Creations that are built from instructions or kits will not be eligible to win, although they may be displayed as part of the contest, if space permits.
- Each creation must be no bigger than 15" by 15" and no taller than 15" high. These dimensions are equivalent to one large grey baseplate.
- By submitting their creation, participants are giving the Scugog Memorial Public Library permission to display their work within the library and to share photos of it through the library's Social Media channels and website. Photos of submitted creations may be used in future promotional material.
- The Scugog Memorial Public Library is not responsible for any damage or loss to a creation that results from the creation being placed on display or moved while in the library.
- Participants must submit an entry form along with their creation(s) when they bring their finished project(s) to the library. Entry forms are available at the Information Desk.
- Drop-off: Participants must drop-off their creations at the library on one of the following dates, during regular library hours:
 - o Thursday, August 15th
 - o Friday, August 16th
 - Saturday, August 17th
 - Sunday, August 18th
 - o Monday, August 19th
- The cutoff for entries is 6 pm on Monday, August 19th. No additional entries can be added after this
 date.
- Pick-up: Creations will be on display until Sunday, August 26 at 5 pm. Entrants are responsible for picking up their creations from the library during library hours between Monday, August 27 and Saturday, August 31, 2024.
- Prizes: One grand prize will be awarded per category. If a duo or team wins a prize, they must split
 the prize as they see fit. Winners must be able to pick up their prize from the Scugog Memorial
 Public Library. Winners will be chosen by judges comprised of library staff. All decisions of the
 judges are final.
