## New at your Library: Puzzles!

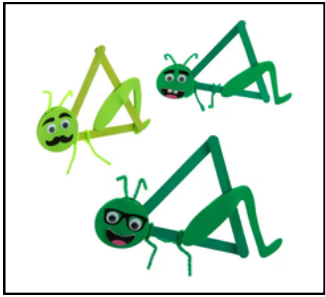


By popular request, puzzles are now available to borrow from your library!

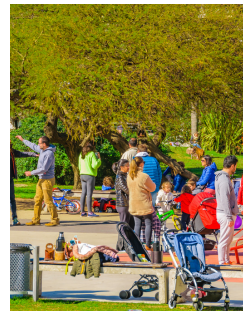


### Toddler Time
